**BID REQUEST:**

Bid for 8oz cartons NON Fat Flavored chocolate and strawberry milk.

Bid for 8oz carton 1% White Milk.

Bid for 8oz carton 1% Flavored chocolate and strawberry Milk. (This may be an option for future meal requirement changes in the National Schools Breakfast and Lunch Programs)

**Hudson Area Schools** participates in the Summer Lunch Program. Must be available to deliver during the summer months of June, July and August.

**Specifications:**

The vendor is to assume all responsibility of transport of items and unloading items to district. Inspection of truck for cleanliness and temperatures when requested by Food Service Director. Product will need to be unloaded and loaded into designated milk coolers/walk-in refrigerator. Product **MUST BE** clean and come in clean crates.

Any damaged product will need to be credited to the School Districts Food Service Department.

Product can only be stacked 5 crates high and placed on provided shelves.

**NO** product is to be left on the floor. Please use the provided shelves.

Dates need to be facing forward.

Rotation of stock is a **MUST**.

Removal of empty milk crates.

Must provide emergency contact information to District Food Service Director.

Food Service Director will provide emergency contact information.

**Hudson Area Schools** anticipates a purchase of items being bid but is under no obligation to make such a purchase. All bids received will be evaluated to determine the best purchase for Addison Community Schools and such evaluation may include factors other than cost.

### **Buy American Provision**

**Cancellation/Termination of contract:** The District reserves the right to discontinue purchasing from the vendor with a 30 day notice from the last delivery time on the day of notice due to unacceptable products and/or service at the sole discretion of the **Hudson Area Schools**.

The District will give vendor ample notice of product issue or service that needs addressed. District will document any findings for product issues or service related concerns.
